- 14th – 16th April 2026





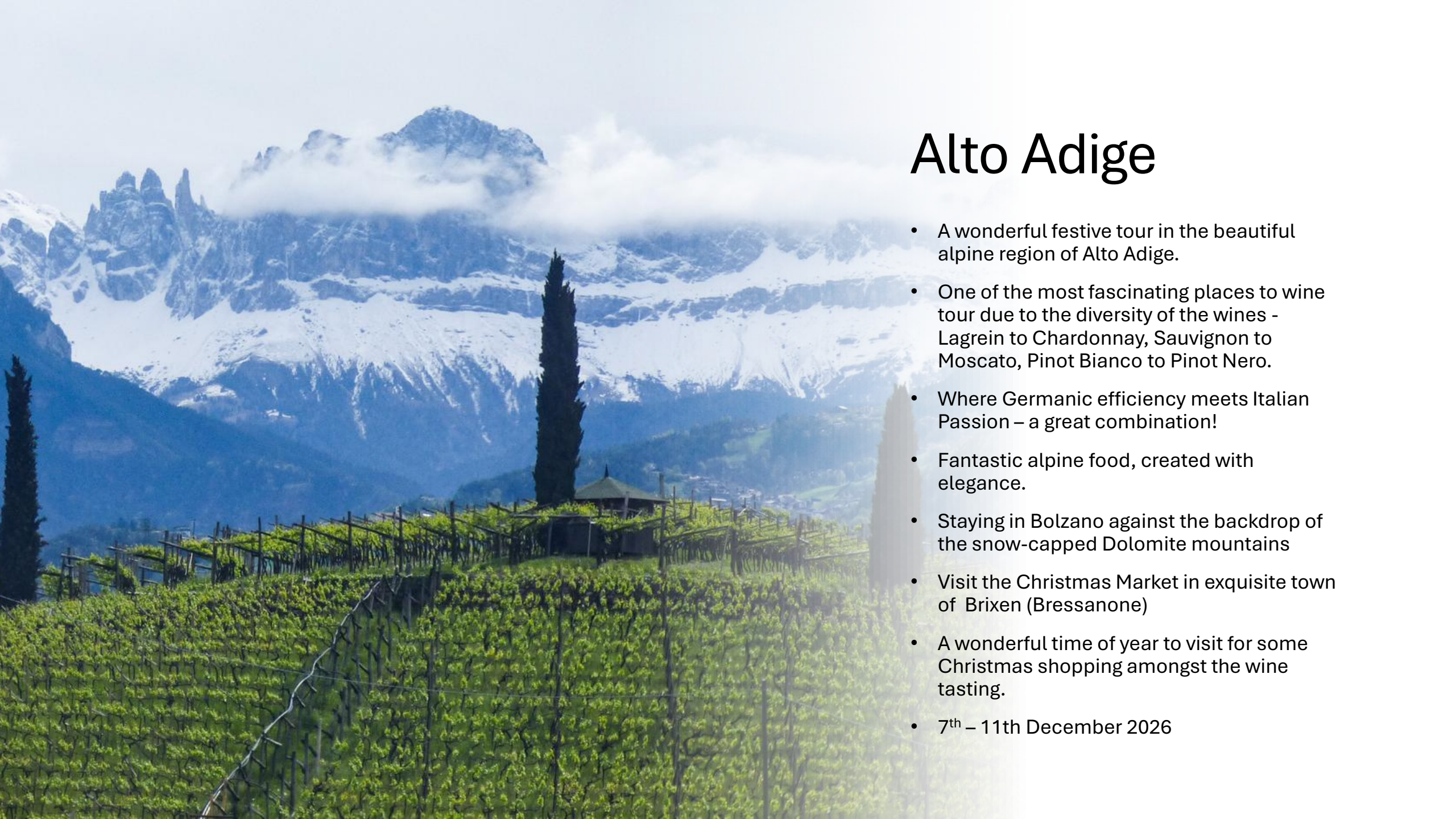
Gavi & Oltrepo Pavese

- Gavi has long been a favourite Italian white of wine lovers around the world. Join us in East Piemonte, in NW Italy, to discover how delightful Gavi can be when made with love & care!
- Timorasso is undergoing a renaissance as a white grape variety in Piemonte, as we discover at our tasting in the Tortona Hills.
- Rolling hills covered with vineyards, dotted with small villages, as we hop over into Lombardia. Oltrepo Pavese is a region still slightly unknown in the UK. We visit a wonderful selection of welcoming family run estates to discover their award-winning wines – Rieslings, Sparklings, Pinot Noirs, but also lesser-known varieties such as Croatina.

Piemonte

- Join Cindy-Marie on her “home” terroir of Piemonte in NW Italy.
- Traveling around the UNESCO World heritage listed Langhe region, with its slopes of vines dotted with hazelnut trees. Tasting ethereal elegant Nebbiolo wines from Barolo & Barbaresco, plus Barbera, Dolcetto, Favorita, Nascetta, Arneis.
- In white truffle season so these aromatic fungi will adorn everything from eggs to pasta!
